Citing Text Evidence

Remember, when you are asked to cite text evidence, we want to see "quotation marks" and quotes directly from the text.

This is the second part of the RACE method: A.C.E.

A: Answer - C: Cite - E: Explain

THE RESERVE

For example:

1. How many dollars **should a plane ticket cost**?

Answer: A plane ticket should cost 8 dollars.

<u>Cite</u>: In paragraph 8, George Washington states, **"8 dollars is the best price for a plane ticket."**

Explain: This proves that 8 dollars is the best price because **Washington is an expert on plane ticket prices.**
